### **Horse Drawn Wagon Rides** 9:00 a.m. — Noon

Take a horse-drawn wagon ride across the covered bridge to the sugar shack—Weather Permitting

**Tractor Wagon Rides** 8:00 a.m.—Noon. Take a tractor-pulled wagon ride across the covered bridge to the sugar shack, if you prefer a tractor to a horse or in case of inclement weather.

### **Sugar Shack, Tree Tapping & Collection Process—**

Come and see a working sugar shack with an evaporator, holding tank, and filtering unit. Learn about the process of making maple syrup from sap

**Reptiles/Amphibians**—Experience & learn about a variety of live reptiles and amphibians with Mic Runyon and his assistants from Camp Palmer

**Portable Sawmill**—Do you have trees that could be harvested? Hiring a portable sawmill operator may be just the answer. Don't miss this demonstration by King Lumber!

**Division of Wildlife—Inflatable BB Gun Range & Archery Range**—Ask local wildlife officer Ethan Bingham all your questions then take aim in the inflatable BB gun range, see how well you do with a bow & arrow or try the archery simulator —All Are Free to Try!
