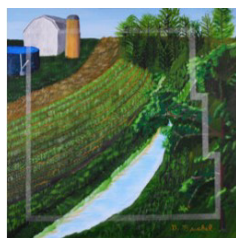

Animal Mortality Composting Certification

This certification covers the science behind composting, best management practices, state regulations, and practical techniques for managing on-farm losses in a safe, environmentally sound way. Participants will gain the knowledge required to meet state composting standards and will leave with the confidence to implement a complaint, sustainable mortality management system in their operation.

This free training session will certify an operator to compost all approved livestock species and is available to all Ohio livestock producers.
